

UNIQUE PROGRAMMES

The opportunity to lead and participate in various school activities.

YPROJECT

One of the pillars of our educational project is **training students in the latest Information Technology.** Every student learns coding, robotics and computer science from a young age using **iPads, MacBooks, 3D printers, Lego Education Innovation Studio Robotix.** The YPROJECT utilizes computational thinking through Problem Based Learning (PBL), Cooperative Learning, Process Based Learning and Learning by Doing.

INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

An inquiry based pedagogical approach that provides students with the opportunity to enhance their learning. Students are launched into the **real life job experience at top local companies**.

STUDENT COUNCIL

The Student Council is committed to amplifying student voices, fostering a vibrant community spirit, and engaging students in a variety of impactful initiatives. Each year, the Council proudly represents the school at key events such as the University Fair, International Day, and new student tours. Through regular meetings with school leadership, they address student concerns and propose innovative solutions.

Their initiatives, like the popular Candy Gram project, participation in Model United Nations, and the creation of a unique commemorative keepsake—designed by students and 3D printed by the Technology Club—highlight their dedication to enhancing the student experience. Proceeds from these efforts support the Yago Foundation and other student-led projects, enriching our school community.

DEBATE

Students have the opportunity to engage in the Spain **European Youth Parliament**, a forum that encourages critical thinking and the expression of their opinions on a wide range of global and societal issues. This initiative fosters an educational spirit focused on addressing the challenges and aspirations of European youth.

Our students also participate in the Model United Nations programme, which immerses them in the world of diplomacy and international relations. Through participation in mock United Nations sessions, the Modelo del Parlamento Europeo (MEP), and the CICAE Pre-University Debate League, students develop essential skills such as research, public speaking, critical thinking, teamwork, and leadership.

YAGO SPORTS ACADEMY

Participation in Sports is highly encouraged at all stages and is reinforced through our extra curricular programme. Students are encouraged to learn innovative sports disciplines and participate in official external sports competitions.

CLUBS

Clubs are created and run by the students, offering a unique opportunity for them to develop their own initiatives. These clubs allow them to organise and manage activities based on their interests, such as sports, art, technology, debating, or social causes. Through this experience, our students gain leadership, teamwork, and time management skills, while also fostering creativity, responsibility, entrepreneurship, self-management, and a strong sense of belonging within the school community.

SCIENCE FAIR

Each year students are able to participate in a science fair with a variety of educational institutions including local schools, universities and research centers. At the Science Fair students have the opportunity to present their science projects and experiments.

SPUTNIK TRANSFORMATION PROJECT SCHOLARSHIP

The Sputnik Project **identifies and mobilizes the most talented and ambitious students**. It promotes entrepreneurship, technology training and encourages them to create start-ups of the future.
